

Supplemental Cookie Notice

This Supplemental Cookie Policy is in addition to the Privacy Policy.

1. Definitions, type of cookies, and application of regulations.
 - a. Cookies are small text files that the websites you visit send and record on your computer or mobile device and are then retransmitted to these websites the next time you visit. It is thanks to cookies that the website remembers your actions and preferences (such as, for example, login details, language chosen, font size, other display settings, etc.) so that they do not need to be reset when you return to that site or browse from one page to another.
 - b. Cookies are used to perform computer authentication, session monitoring, and storage of information regarding your activities when you access a website. They may also contain a unique identification code that allows to keep track of your browsing experience within the website for statistical or advertising purposes. Some operations could not be performed without the use of cookies; so in some cases, they are technically essential for the very operation of the website.

 - d. Cookies may be cookies that are set directly by the website or web server you are visiting or cookies the website whose address you have typed and which appears in the URL window (so-called “first-party” cookies).
 - e. When browsing a site, you may also receive cookies from websites or web servers other than the one you are visiting (so-called “third-party” cookies). When you visit a website and a third party other than the manager of the website you are visiting releases a cookie, which is owned by such third party, through such website, such cookie is referred to as a third-party cookie.
 - f. There are various types of cookies, depending on their characteristics and functions, and they may be stored on your computer for different periods of time: so-called session cookies, which are automatically deleted when the browser is closed; so-called persistent cookies, which remain on your device for a specifically established period of time.
 - g. In accordance with applicable regulations in force, the use of cookies does not always require your consent. Specifically, technical cookies, i.e. those used for the sole purpose of transmitting a communication over an electronic communications network, or as strictly necessary to provide a service explicitly requested by you, may not require such consent. Among the technical cookies that do not require express consent for their use, applicable regulations in force in Italy include the following:
 - i. First-party analytical cookies, which are used in an aggregated manner to collect information about the number of users and how they visit the website;

- ii. Third-party analytical cookies, when tools are adopted that reduce the identification power of cookies and the third party does not cross-check the information gathered with other information already in its possession;
 - iii. Browsing or session cookies (used for authentication and service access);
 - iv. Functionality cookies that allow you to browse depending on several selected criteria (e.g. language) in order to improve the service provided to you.
 - h. However, Profiling cookies, i.e., cookies designed to create profiles referring to you and used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences you expressed while surfing the web, require your prior consent.
 - i. Your consent is also requested for Third-party analytical cookies when tools are not adopted that reduce the identification power of cookies and the third party cross-checks the information gathered with other information already in its possession.
- 2. Type of cookies used by the Website
 - a. The Website uses the following types of cookies:
 - i. Browsing or session technical cookies, strictly necessary for the operation of the Website or for allowing you to access the contents and Services requested;
 - ii. Functionality cookies, i.e. used to enable specific Website functions and to configure the Website depending on your choices (e.g. language), in order to improve your experience. We inform you that if you disable technical and/or functionality cookies, you may not be able to consult the Website, or certain services or specific features of the Website may not function properly and you may need to change or manually enter certain information or preferences each time you visit the Website.
 - iii. Analytical cookies, which allow QubicaAMF, the software partner we use to provide functionality on this Website, to understand how the Website is used by you and to identify traffic coming in and out of the Website. In this respect, QubicaAMF uses the Google Analytics service (as provided by Google Inc, hereinafter “Google”) according to the following conditions: measures are taken that reduce the identification power of the cookies by masking portions of the IP (as described at: <https://support.google.com/analytics/answer/2763052?hl=i>). QubicaAMF has accepted the amendment to data protection with Google through which Google undertakes to use these cookies exclusively for providing the service, to store them separately and not to “enhance” or “cross-check” them with other information that is in its possession. On this matter, we inform you that QubicaAMF has not linked Google Analytics to any additional Google services and that no advertising or data sharing options have been set up with Google. We also remind you that you can install a Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on (<https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=en>). - iv. Regarding third-party cookies: third parties are typically data controllers that are independent of QubicaAMF for any data gathered through the cookies they use (and the data they gather is used for their own purposes and according to the terms they set). So please refer to their personal data processing policies, notices and consent forms (by selecting and deselecting the respective cookies) as detailed in the table below.
3. How to manage or delete cookies.
 - a. You can authorize, block, or delete (in whole or in part) any cookies through the specific settings of your Browser. If you use several devices to view and access the Website (e.g., computers, smartphones, tablets, etc.), it is your responsibility to make sure that the browser on each device is adjusted to reflect your preferences on cookies.
